

AMERICAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM
First-week Activities Schedule
Autumn Quarter 2008

We are pleased you are coming to Columbus, Ohio. You should arrive no later than September 18th. If you do not already have firm housing arrangements, you should arrive at least one week earlier.

As soon as you arrive in Columbus, it is important for you to call or visit the American Language Program (ALP) office (65 Arps Hall, 1945 North High Street, telephone 292-1364). **We need to know that you have arrived, and we would like to meet you.** See the attached map for the location of ALP.

Below is a brief schedule of activities for the first week of the Autumn Quarter 2008. When you arrive, you will receive a schedule with more detail, including times and locations for each activity.

• **Within 24 to 48 hours after arrival in Columbus:**

Visit the ALP office to introduce yourself, check in, and sign up to take the English placement test (given on Friday September 19th). The ALP office is open 8:30 am – 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 pm – 4:30 pm Monday through Friday.

PLEASE NOTE: University Offices are closed on all Saturdays and Sundays, and for a holiday on Monday September 1st.

- Bring your passport.
- If you are a sponsored student, you must bring your letter of billing authorization
 - If you are a sponsored student, you must bring proof of medical (health) insurance.

Visit the Office of Residence and Dining Halls, 3rd Floor, Morrill Tower (1900 Cannon Drive) if you have already made arrangements to live in a University dormitory.
