#### COLLEGE ENTRANCE RECOMMENDATIONS

To assist students in making a smooth transition from the high school to college the Ohio Department of Education and the Ohio Board of Regents recommend a college preparatory program which includes:

- 4 years of English, with emphasis on composition
- 3 years of mathematics (algebra I, II & plane geometry, one of which should be taken in the senior year).
- 3 years of science
- 3 years of social studies
- 2 years of foreign language
- 1 year of fine, applied, or performing arts
